## A. Connect the Camera to the Power Supply.



- Connect the Micro USB plug of the power adapter to the Camera and the other end to a suitable electrical outlet. The LED indicator lights up in red.
- Slide the ON/OFF switch to the ON position. The LED status indicator lights up in blue.

B. Connect the Smart Nursery Monitor to the Power Supply.

- Press and hold the U POWER ON/OFF button for 2 seconds to turn on the Smart Nursery Monitor.
