

1. Setting up your Digital Video Baby Monitor

A. Baby unit power supply.

MODELS: MBP667CONNECT MBP667CONNECT-2 MBP667CONNECT-3 MBP667CONNECT-4




- Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC socket on the back of the Baby Unit.
- Connect the other end of the power adapter to a suitable electrical outlet.
- Slide the ON/OFF switch to the ON position. The power/link indicator lights up.

Note Only use the supplied power adapter.

B. Install battery pack for the Parent Unit.



Strangulation Hazard: Children have STRANGLED in cords. Keep this cord out of the reach of children (more than 3ft away). Never use extension cords with AC Adapters. Only use the AC Adapters provided.



- A rechargeable battery pack is supplied and should be installed and charged, so that the Parent Unit can be moved without losing the link and picture from the Baby Unit(s).
- Remove the battery compartment cover.
- Insert the plug of the battery pack into the socket inside the battery compartment, and fit the battery pack into the compartment.
- Replace the battery compartment cover, and pull out the desktop stand.



C. Parent Unit Power Supply.



 Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC socket on the side of the Parent Unit.

Connect the other end of the power adapter to a suitable electrical outlet. The battery level indicator lights up in green.

 To turn the Parent Unit on or off, press and hold the power button <u>u</u>.

Ā	Talk button	Press and hold to speak to your baby.

3. Setting up the Camera Unit for Wi-Fi[®] Internet Viewing

A. Install Hubble for Motorola Monitors App.



- Scan the QR code with your smart device and download the Hubble for Motorola Monitors App from the App Store for iOS devices or from the Google PlayTM Store for AndroidTM devices.
- Install Hubble for Motorola Monitors App on your device.

B. View on Compatible Smartphones, Tablets and Computers.



- 1. Open the Hubble for Motorola Monitors App on your compatible smartphone or tablet.
- 2. Follow the in-app instructions to create your Hubble account and connect to your Wi-Fi[®] Camera.
- Log in to your account on your compatible smartphone, tablet or via https://app.hubbleconnected.com/#login on your PC to access your live camera stream.

This Warranty is your exclusive warranty and is not transferable.

Who is covered?

This Warranty extends only to the first consumer purchaser, and is not transferable.

What will BINATONE do?

BINATONE or its authorized distributor at its option and within a commercially reasonable time, will at no charge repair or replace any Products or Accessories that does not conform to this Warranty. We may use functionally equivalent reconditioned/ refurbished/ pre-owned or new Products, Accessories or parts.
